We are very excited to announce the '2nd LSE Reason, Knowledge and Values Colloquium' in Week 3 of the Summer term (date and venue to be confirmed).

We want to invite all PH103 undergraduate students to participate in the Colloquium; we hope everyone will join in the debate but in addition we are looking for volunteers to make a presentation, on a topic of your choice studied during the year. The main purpose of the colloquium is to revise the course topics collectively in preparation for the exam. We believe you will benefit from the opportunity to test and debate your arguments in the presence of your colleagues and class teachers. Other members of the philosophy department and other LSE undergraduate students will also be invited to attend.

As a speaker you will have to turn your essay into a few slides or a hand-out, and prepare yourself for giving a short talk presenting those ideas and arguments of your own making. Joint registrations with more than one student working on the same presentation are welcome. Students are also welcome to seek advice from the class teachers on their presentation. The colloquium will be an official LSE event and will be publicized. This means it will have CV value for the speakers, and a signed letter-headed acknowledgement will be given to each speaker.

Please register soon as a speaker because there is a *limited* number of places available. The deadline for registration is: **Thursday 13**th **March**. Do not send slides or hand-out, leave these for the time of your presentation.
