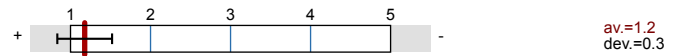

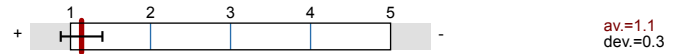

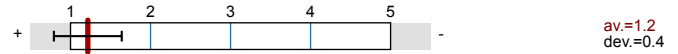

Class/Seminar Teacher Evaluation (Scale width: 5)

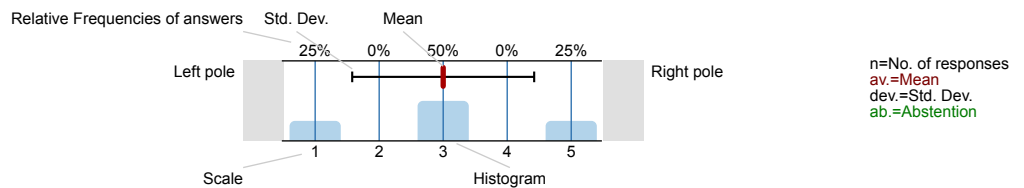


Course Evaluation (Scale width: 5)

Sometimes perhaps more anecdotes & examples to help us get things faster. Also translating some of corporate vocab at times too.

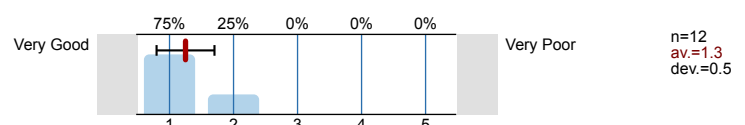

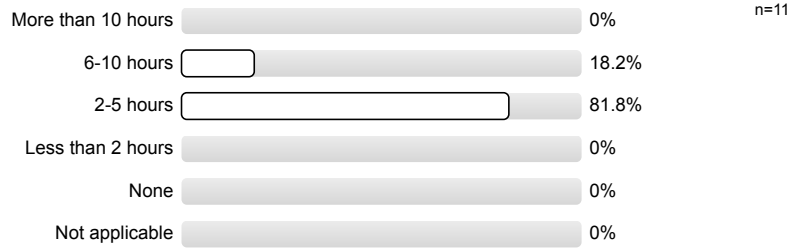
If I were to be very nitpicky, I noticed various spelling errors in the handouts. Otherwise, the handouts are very useful and content is well structured and communicated.

More interaction with the statutes. I feel we could move through certain "basics" subject matter more quickly and spend more time on complexities.

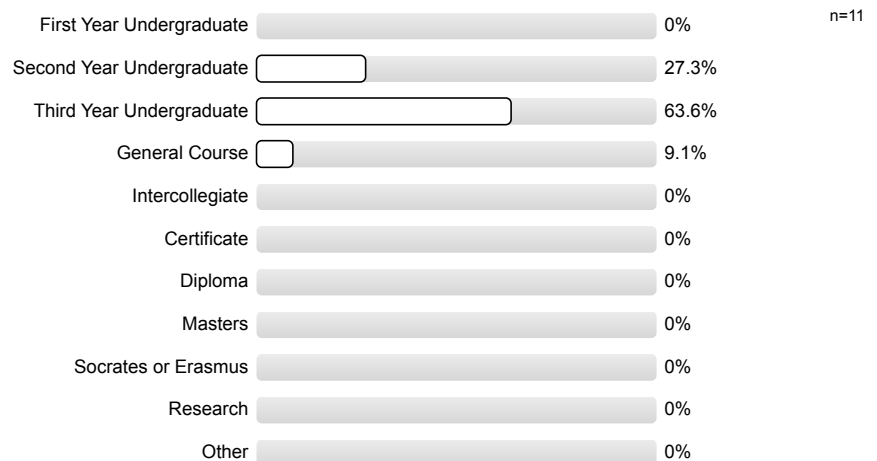

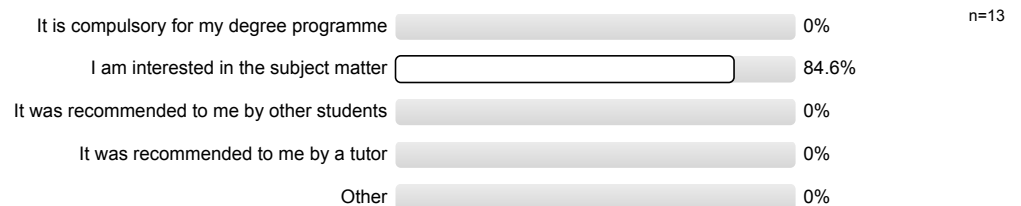

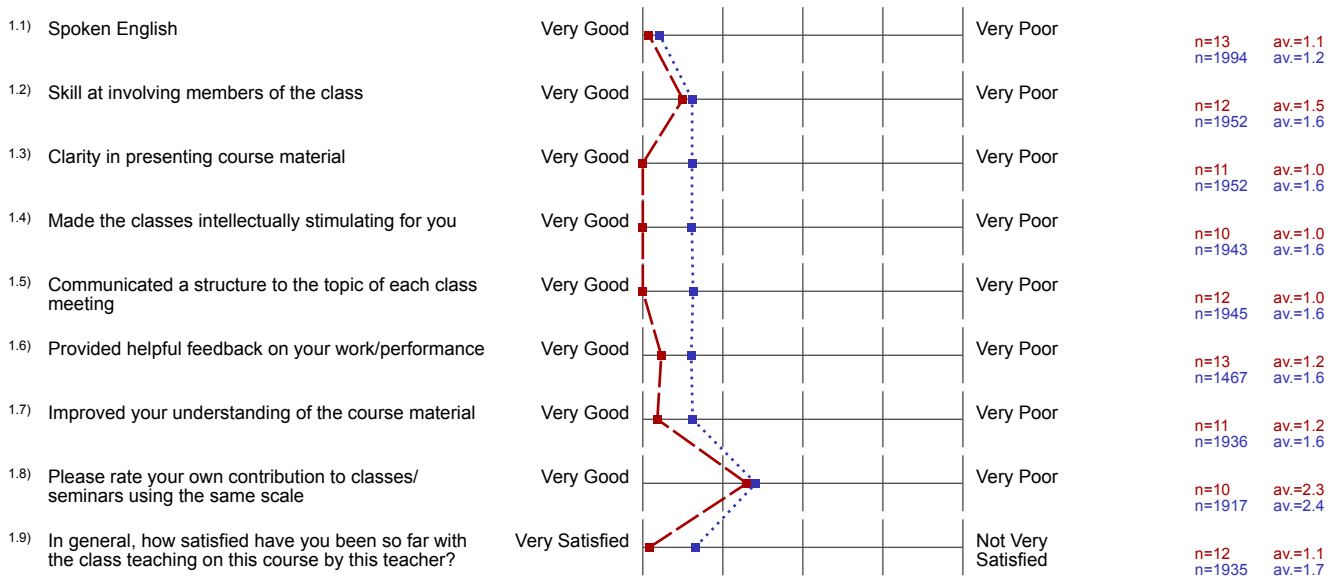
