BIO

Andrés Rodríguez-Pose is the Princesa de Asturias Chair and a Professor of Economic Geography at the London School of Economics. He is the Director of the Cañada Blanch Centre LSE and was Head of the Department of Geography and Environment between 2006 and 2009.

Since 2022 he has been chairing the European Union's (EU) High-level Group on the Future of Cohesion Policy, which is responsible for proposing the new Cohesion Policy for the European Union (EU) post-2027. The EU's Cohesion Policy is the largest development policy in the world, with a budget of €392 billion for the period 2021-2027.

He has been President of the Regional Science Association International (RSAI) (2015-2017) and served as its Vice-President in 2014. He was also Vice-President (2012-2013) and Secretary (2001-2005) of the European Regional Science Association.

He is a part-time Professor of Innovation at the Centre for Innovation Research, University of Stavanger (Norway). He has been visiting professor at several higher education institutions, including the College of Europe (Belgium), the University of Cambridge (UK), the University of Hannover (Germany), the University of Split (Croatia), and the Autonomous University of Madrid (Spain).

He has a long track record of research in regional growth and inequality, trade, innovation, fiscal and political decentralization, institutions, discontent and populism, migration, and development and industrial policies and strategies. This research is widely cited in academic circles. In the 2023 Stanford/Elsevier list of the 2% most cited scientists (which identifies close to 200,000 researchers across all areas of science), he was among the top 1,000 researchers in the world across all academic disciplines. He was ranked first worldwide in the field of urban and regional planning by scholarly citations both in in 2023 and 2021. He also appears on Clarivate's Web of Science 2020, 2001, 2022, and 2023 lists of Highly Cited Researchers.

His research is also influential in policy circles. In his areas of expertise, he has regularly acted as advisor to several Directorates of the European Commission, the World Bank, the Cities Alliance, the OECD, the International Labour Organization, UNCTAD, the United Nations Development Programme, the Food and Agriculture Organization, the European Investment Bank, the Inter-American Development Bank, the Development Bank of Latin America, the Asian Development Bank, or the African Union.

Among his honours is the 2018 ERSA Prize in Regional Science, considered to be among the highest awards in the field. He has been a holder of a European Research Council (ERC) Advanced Grant and of a prestigious Royal Society-Wolfson Research Merit Award. Other past academic prizes include a Leverhulme Trust Major Research Fellowship, a Philip Leverhulme Prize, and the Royal Geographical Society Gill Memorial Award. The latter two were awarded for his contribution to the understanding of regional disparities and development.

He has been awarded Doctorates *Honoris Causa* by Utrecht University (the Netherlands) and Jönköping University (Sweden).

His books include *The dynamics of Regional Growth in Europe* (Oxford, Oxford University Press, 1998), *The European Union: Economy, Society, and Polity* (Oxford, Oxford University Press, 2002), *Local and Regional Development* (London, Routledge, 2006 and 2017 2nd Edition), *Innovation and regional growth in the European Union* (Berlin and New York, Springer, 2011), or *Technology and Industrial Parks in Emerging Countries* (Heidelberg and New York, Springer, 2014). Some of his books have been translated into Chinese, Italian, and Spanish. He has also published more than 240 articles in international peer-reviewed journals.

He is an editor of *Economic Geography*, and sits on the editorial board of 45 other scholarly journals, including many of the leading international journals in economic geography, human geography, regional science, political science, and management. Between 1999 and 2016 he was editor of *Environment and Planning C*, acting as joint chief editor from 2008 onwards. He was also editor-in-chief of the *Journal of Geographical Systems* between 2019 and 2021.

- Andrés Rodríguez-Pose has been ranked first worldwide in the 2023 and 2021 Stanford/Elsevier lists of
 the 2% most cited scientists (which identifies close to 200,000 researchers across all areas of science by
 scholarly citations) in the field of urban and regional planning.
- In that list he ranks among the top 1,000 top researchers in the world across all academic disciplines, according to his scientific citations in 2022.
- He is named in 2023, for the fourth year in a row, among Clarivate's **Highly Cited Researchers**. This list recognises around 7,000 scholars across all disciplines who have produced multiple highly-cited papers that rank in the top 1% by citations for field and year in the Web of Science. He is among the 230 researchers worldwide recognised in the social science category.
- As of November 2023, he had twelve highly cited (top 1% in each of the 22 ESI subject areas) in Clarivate's
 Essential Science Indicators (ESI). Of those twelve highly cited papers, five were also research frontier
 articles.
- Despite being a geographer, Andrés Rodríguez-Pose is also highly ranked as an economist. According to RePEc, at the beginning of December 2023, he was ranked 329th in the world ranking of economists (93rd when only the last 10 years of publications are taken into account). He is the top ranked geographer on the list. He was also the 22nd economist in the UK (and 5th in the country when only the last 10 years are considered).
- In RePEc he was also among the top-15 economists in the world in the fields of Economic Geography (5th),

Microeconomic European Issues (8th), Small Business Management (11th), and Urban & Real Estate Economics (11th).
